Note: Students must complete entire core curriculum prior to applying to Texas A&M Corpus Christi, which includes ENGL 1302, HIST 1301 and 1302, GOVT 2305 and 2306, Creative Arts or LPC (whichever was not taken), SPCH, AND MATH 1342. Texas A&M Corpus Christi also requires CHEM 1411 for admission into the nursing program. At least two high school credits in one foreign language or American Sign Language OR two semesters of study with passing grades in a single foreign language or American Sign Language at the college level are required for graduation from Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi. This requirement may be met by earning a CLEP, AP, or ACTFL score equivalent to one year of college-level foreign language study. Please see an Advisor to determine when best to take these courses.
